

1                   Transfer form. And this is page two of three  
2 pages of the transfer form.

3                   THE COURT: Transfer form relating to?

4                   MS. CURTIS: The Exxon/Mobil stock.

5                   THE COURT: Okay.

6                   MS. CURTIS: And so, at the top of the page my  
7 sister Anita's 160 shares, and the bottom of the page is my  
8 160 shares.

9                                 There is two signatures at the bottom of the  
10 page. One is on a W-9 portion, and the other is on, my  
11 understanding that the money would be reinvested in the  
12 account. These signatures are not my signatures; they're  
13 forgeries.

14                   THE COURT: Uh-huh.

15                   MS. CURTIS: I would not have seen these if I had  
16 not had this shared with me by my brother.

17                   THE COURT: And you didn't authorize anyone to make  
18 those signatures for you?

19                   MS. CURTIS: No, I did not. And I have filed a  
20 Securities & Exchange Commission complaint as of last week  
21 about this.

22                   THE COURT: All right.

23                   MS. CURTIS: And I have not heard anything from them  
24 since that time.
