
ORDER ON MOTION FOR FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

On August 4, 2022, the Court received the Motion for Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law filed by Candace Curtis, requesting findings and conclusions relevant to a Summary Judgment Order signed in this matter on February 25, 2022.

The Court finds that Tex. R. Civ. P. 296 requires that a request for Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law be filed within 20 days after the date the judgment was signed. Even if the request were timely, the Court further finds that Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are not required, nor appropriate, after the court renders a summary judgment. *IKB Indus. Ltd. V. Pro-line Corp.* 938 SW2nd 440 at 441-42. Therefore, the Motion is DENIED.
