Thank you for contacting our office. You have reached the Crime Victim Assistance Division (CVAD) of the Iowa Attorney General's Office. The mission of CVAD and its Board is to advocate for the rights and the needs of crime victims and ensure that all crime victim survivors will be treated with respect and dignity.
