QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether a corporation, which is considered a “person” in accordance with 8 USC 1101(b)(3), was born in the United States in accordance with 8 USC 1401(a) and is a US citizen, can have “sovereign immunity.”
2. Whether a government corporation has sovereign immunity from suit when it can clearly “sue and be sued” in accordance with statute.
3. Whether a removal from State to Federal court can take place under 28 U.S. Code § 1442 when the originating court does not fall under the definition of a “State court” in 28 U.S. Code § 1442(d)(6).
